Case Study - React to Red



Commissioned by Leeds CCG to provide a clinical training solution, across 139 CQC registered healthcare providers, created to empower delegates to develop and enhance their skills and reduce instances of pressure ulcers.

- Provided a framework of competency and continual risk assessments
- Upskilled champions for each provider to disseminate training
- Targeted training for both clinical and non-clinical staff
- Delivered via Face to Face, virtual and through peer-led community events
- Worked collaboratively to allow for targeted promotion
- **KPI**'s were presented and discussed at monthly stakeholder meetings
- Certificates and resources provided to all trainees, including those trained by champions

Case Study - Senior Carers Course



To assist with the impact of staffing challenges in nursing home environments we designed and developed this UpSkill training programme, created to provide the skills, knowledge and confidence to undertake activities traditionally provided by the Nursing team.

- Six-week **blended learning** programme
- Over **18 course subjects** covered for up to 10 learners per programme
- Classroom study with theory-based learning and group activities
- Interactive, engaging practical-based learning
- Framework of competency assessments to complete with a mentor
- Self-directed learning and reflection via an online portal
- Content designed to provide impactful evidence-based learning



Case Study - PC Cancer Screening

In collaboration with Invicta Health CIC, we provide a 4-hour instructor led session to compliment the Primary Care Cancer Screening Awareness Training programme for non-clinical staff in Primary Care, commissioned by HEE and the Kent and Medway Cancer Alliance.

- Facilitated by a specialist **clinical nurse** educator
- Providing training for patient-centered care, targeted to low-participation groups
- Clinical expertise in Cancer Screening pathways
- Empowering non-clinical staff to affect positive change in practice
- Scenario based **group work** and reflection
- Flexible virtual delivery with interactive assessments
